## Cart Registration Fee Waiver Policy

Murrumbidgee Country Club is an inclusive club that encourages Members of all abilities to participate in golfing and social activities.

The Board sets the annual Cart Registration Fee each year for Members who use their personal motorised golf cart on the course.

A Member may apply for this fee to be waived if they meet the following eligibility criteria:

- A. the Member has a permanent disability or a temporary disability, which requires them to use a motorised golf cart on the course;
- B. the Member has a current Australian disability parking permit and supporting medical documents listed in their name; and
- C. the Member complies with the requirements set out in this policy.

For an eligible Member with a temporary disability, the following requirements apply:

1. An application for the fee waiver must be made annually at the start of the financial year on 1 July;
2. A copy of a current valid temporary disability parking permit and supporting medical documents must be produced to the Club's front office and a copy will be kept on record for the financial year the fee waiver applies to;
3. In order to receive a waiver of the full annual Cart Registration Fee, the temporary disability parking permit must be valid for the full financial year. If the eligible Member's permit is only valid for part of the financial year, the Club will grant a pro rata fee waiver based on the period that the Member's permit is valid;
4. Once the eligible Member's application is approved, the fee waiver will apply for the Club's financial year commencing on 1<sup>st</sup> July and ending on 30<sup>th</sup> June, unless a pro rata fee waiver is granted; and
5. If, throughout the financial year, the eligible Member's permit is revoked or cancelled, the Member must inform the Club.

For an eligible Member with a permanent disability, the following requirements apply:

1. An application for the fee waiver is to be made at the start of the financial year;
2. A copy of a current valid permanent disability parking permit and supporting medical documents must be produced to the Club's front office and a copy will be kept on record for the financial year/s the fee waiver applies to;
3. If on application, the eligible Member obtained the permanent disability parking permit part way through that financial year, the Club will grant a pro rata fee waiver for the first financial year, and a full fee waiver for subsequent financial years; and
4. If a fee waiver is granted, it will be valid for a maximum of 5 years until the expiry of the eligible Member's permanent disability parking permit. At the end of that period, the eligible Member can apply for a renewal of the fee waiver subject to the provision of a copy of their renewed permanent disability parking permit to the Club's front office.
