

DANGEROUS WEATHER POLICY

In the event of lightning or dangerous weather conditions in the vicinity of the golf course, a warning horn and golf alert system will be operated by the Pro Shop.

The golf alert system is a recorded voice message. It will operate during dangerous weather conditions. There is a station located on the front 9, the back 9 & at the Pro Shop.

Upon hearing the horn or golf alert system, all players are to cease play IMMEDIATELY. When play is suspended, players are to mark and life their ball in accordance with Rule 5.7d. Players are not to resume play until the committee has allowed resumption of play to commence. If resumption of play is allowed, players must need to be aware that their round must be completed by 1700 AEST or 1800 AEDST should they elect to continue playing.

DISCONTINUE OF PLAY

Siren: One prolonged note of the siren - 15 seconds

Announcement: Play has been suspended due to a dangerous situation; all players must stop play immediately.

Repeated

Siren: Three consecutive notes of the siren

(3 secs - 1 sec gap - 3 secs - 1 sec gap - 3 secs)

Announcement: Play has been suspended for a non-dangerous situation, players may stop play immediately or complete the hole they are playing.

Repeated

RESUMPTION OF PLAY

Siren: Two consecutive notes of the siren ($3 \sec s - 1 \sec gap - 3 \sec s$)

Announcement: Play has been resumed; players may recommence play.

Repeated

Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in disqualification from the competition.
