TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- The Murrumbidgee Country Club Women's Match Committee reserve the right to alter or to make any variations to these conditions of play as necessary including the right to refuse entry. The Match Committee, whose decision is final, will settle all disputes. Any member of the Match Committee involved in a dispute will not be eligible to render any ruling on that dispute.
- Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Murrumbidgee Country Club.
- The competition is open to all women with a Golf Australia handicap in the range + to 54.
- The format for the competition is Division 1 and 2: Stroke, Division 3: Stableford.
- Handicap divisions will be determined by the Match Committee once the entries have closed.
- Entries should be submitted via the online form on the Murrumbidgee website site and will close Sunday 11 May 2025.
- Play will be 9am shotgun start. Players must register before 8.30am to enable play to commence on schedule.
- Play will be from the RED tees.
- The draw will be placed on the club website as soon as practicable after close of entries.
- All ties will be determined by the Golf Australia method of count back.
- With the exception of the Perpetual Trophies and NTPs, a player is not eligible to win more than one prize.
- Eligibility for the Junior prizes is limited to those who are 18 years of age or younger at the date of the competition.
- Caddies are not permitted. Bag pullers are allowed but their role is limited to assistance with scoring and the rules of golf. Bag pullers may not coach players during the round nor assist with alignment, shot selection or club selection.
- All competitors are required to abide by the dress requirements of the Murrumbidgee Country Club
- Distance measuring devices may be used as described under R&A Rules of Golf rule 4.3a.
- Mobile phones may be carried but must be in silent mode at all times. A player may use
 mobile phones for distance measuring, scoring or any other purpose but its use must not
 interfere with or disrupt another player.
- Motorised transport may be used by players unless carts are banned from the course on the day of play due to adverse course conditions.
- Carts will be booked with the Golf-shop by calling 02 62965580
- There will be no refunds provided for cancellations advised after the draw has been completed. Exception – cart usage banned due to course conditions.
